

Cruise 1 Calvi – Bonifacio – Porto Cervo

Calvi



In Calvi you will find plenty of water sports activities available on the beach. If you are a diver you will be able to use one of the local schools and dive down to the WW2 bomber located at the base of Calvi rock. For a berth in the port a reservation is required. There is also a Michelin star restaurant here called “Le Table de Bastien” located at “La Villa”; for reservations tel. +33 (0) 495 65 10 10.

Porto Marina



Porto Marina, located in the same golfe as Girolata, (although a few miles to the south) is a stunning small village located right on the coast, hidden from the sea! As the name suggests it is a port, although on the rather small side, so tenders only! This is well worth a trip ashore. Approximately a 2.5 hour cruise from Calvi. There is also a great restaurant in Girolata called “Le Bel Ombra”; for reservations tel.+33 (0) 495 20 15 67.

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Campomoro/Propriano



Campomoro is located approximately three quarters of the way down the island of Corsica and is a great spot for an overnight anchorage where water sports and sun bathing can be enjoyed. Approximately a 5 hour cruise from Porto Marina.

Bonifacio



For me Bonifacio is the jewel on Corsica's crown, with a stunning entrance to the port. The small streets of the citadel are a joy to be explored. There are also a number of excellent restaurants just along the port, "La Caravelle" being one of them; for reservations tel. +33 495 73 00 03. There is a smaller restaurant called the "Kissing Pigs", which is a nice low-key spot to sample local Corsican wine and charcuterie.

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Rondinara



Rondinara is a stunning “horse shoe bay” to stop at for lunch (amongst many other choices) around the Lavezzi islands area whilst on route to the bay of Pinarellu for a night anchorage. Approximately a 1 hour cruise from Bonifacio.

Pinarellu



Pinarellu is a great spot for an overnight anchorage. The sheltered shallow bay offers a great opportunity for swimming and various water sports. Also on the beach is a fantastic fish restaurant, which is well visiting. Pinarellu is approximately a 1 hour cruise north from Rondinara.

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Maddalena Islands (Sardinia)



Italian archipelago just of the coast of Sardinia, a stunning place to explore once anchored in one of the many available bays. As it is a nature reserve motorized water sports are limited. The cruise from Pinerellu is approximately 2 hours.

Cala di Volpe



After a short cruise from the Maddalena islands (approx. 1 hour), drop anchor in the Cala di Volpe, the place of the stars! Lunch is always available at the world famous hotel; "Hotel Cala di Volpe" tel; +39 0789976111. Then later cruising to Porto Cervo for the evening.

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Porto Cervo



Porto Cervo was purpose built by Prince Karim Aga Khan as a playground for the rich and famous. This is a world famous part of the Mediterranean – not to be missed!
